**<sup>1</sup> Transit districts**

Fulton	No countywide transit district.
Lucas	District includes all of Lucas County and transitioned from property levies to funding via a 0.50% sales tax effective April 2022.
Monroe	No countywide transit district.
Ottawa	Ottawa County Transportation Agency not supported by property levy.
Wood	TARTA serves City of Rossford in Wood County.

**<sup>2</sup> Park districts**

Fulton	No countywide park district.
Lucas	Metroparks Toledo includes all of Lucas County.
Monroe	Monroe County Park System not supported by property levy.
Ottawa	Ottawa County Park District includes all of Ottawa County.
Wood	Wood County Park District includes all of Wood County.

**<sup>3</sup> Library districts**

Fulton	No countywide library district.
Lucas	Toledo Lucas County Public Library includes all of Lucas County except for areas in Swanton Local School District.
Monroe	Monroe County Library System includes all of Monroe County.
Ottawa	No countywide library district.
Wood	Wood County District Public Library includes all of Wood County except for areas served by the Kaubisch Memorial, North Baltimore, Pemberville, Rossford, Way, Wayne and Weston Public Libraries.
