The Small Business Development Center (SBDC) at the Toledo Regional Chamber of Commerce offers assistance to entrepreneurs in all stages of the business lifecycle, whether they are beginning their business endeavor or are looking to grow their existing operation. The SBDC provides no-cost one-on-one counseling centered around the business planning process, including financing, market research, marketing strategies, and management and cash flow analysis. Additionally, the Ohio SBDC Export Assistance Network at the Toledo Regional Chamber of Commerce can help companies to diversify their portfolios and to weather changes in the domestic economy by entering, or expanding, into exporting. Chamber membership is not required to utilize these services.
