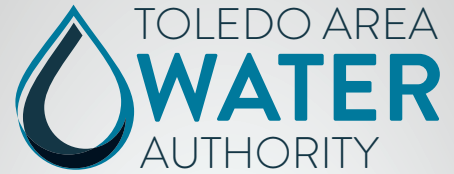

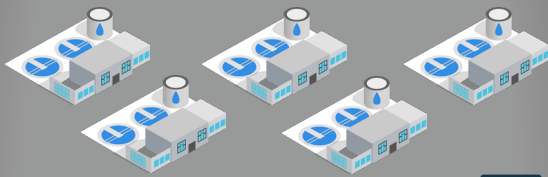

The number of water facilities that are leased and maintained under the GLWA agreement.

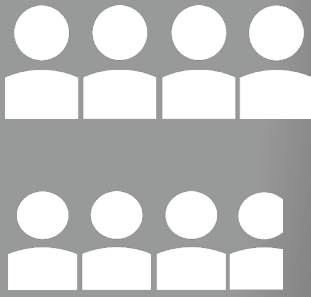
